MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS

- · Helmet, gloves, appropriate clothing for cycling practice
- Road Bike Wheels 700C (maximum wheel width 32mm)
- Clips or automatic pedal hooking system (except: Novice Category)
- Only road handlebars are allowed, aero-bars, straight handlebars or raised tip handlebars are not allowed for any reason.
- Only wheels with spokes are allowed, lenticular wheels or blades are not allowed.

REGULATIONS

- For OPEN MEN'S CATEGORY: applies: "Competitor reached (lapped) will be eliminated and will have to leave the race"
- The designation of the lap sprints will be done by raffle among the judges, prior to the competition and will only be announced to the competitors with the ringing of the bell.

RESULTS

- LIVE RESULTS on site, will be carried out in real time through a monitor next to the timing tent, where lap details of the competitors will be shown.

- NOT OFFICIAL FINAL RESULTS will be printed and will be placed in view of all competitors and the end of each group.
- OFFICAL FINAL RESULTS will be online as of MONDAY 11TH OF JULY.

TIMES AND JUDGES

Disposable electronic chips will be used for timing, as well as to determine the final positions and the winners of the lap sprints – Timing will be done by **ECTiming** and evidence of the finishing will be filmed. The judges will be appointed by the organizing committee and all protests must be submitted in writing no later than 15 minutes after the results of the event are announced, accompanied by \$1,000.00 Mexican pesos as guarantee.

REFRESHMENT STATIONS

- · Refreshment station will be on foot, only in the area designated by the organizing committee and is sole responsibility of each competitor and/or team
- . For safety reasons, only one (1) water bottle is allowed per bike
- Competitors and/or teams are highly recommended to bring repellent, folding chairs and tents for their teams that may be placed in designated areas assigned by the organizing committee, so that they can be identified by their competitors, and in addition to being useful, create an excellent family atmosphere.

PRE-RACE MEETING AND COMPETITORS NUMBERS

- The information will be given prior to the start, moments before the start of each group.
- . Race number pick up will be at the FINISH LINE area, one hour before the departure of your group. We recommend you arrive earlier

WEATHER AND RAIN

- In the unforeseen event that there is rain BEFORE the event, the organizing committee will have to verify that the entire circuit surface is dry, since this type of surface is very slippery with water, it could lead to a delay in the race event from one to two hours maximum
- In the event that the decision is made that it is not possible to compete due to the wet surface, the event will be postponed one day, and will be held on the following: SUNDAY, JULY 10, at the same times.

ROAD INFRASTRUCTURE AND PARKING

- The event will take place on a circuit designed on the internal streets of MALECON TAJAMAR in Cancun. The circuit will be completely closed to vehicular traffic, with fences, tape and support from Municipal Transit Police
- · All street entries will be closed with fences, cones and tape, to prevent competitors from doing shortcuts, as well as prevent cars from entering the circuit.
- . Competitors cars and their companions, can park along the open streets of MALECON TAJAMAR, outside the competition circuit.

THEFT, ACCIDENTS AND LIABILTY

- The organizing committee is NOT responsible for theft, accidents, injuries and/or damage to people, equipment, cars or bicycles; before, during and after the competition. Being a sports competition that involves being in a space open to the public and, in turn, also involves riding at high speed in a peloton, it falls within the category of sports with SPORTS RISK DUE TO SPEED, so we recommend widely, that the competitors and participants, for cycling competitions, always have insurance against accidents that covers the damages, in case of suffering an accident before, during and after the event, that they can respond before the mishaps.
- In order to participate, every competitor must have signed their liability waiver before beginning their participation, otherwise they will not be able to start the event. The signing of this document determines that the competitor has read, understands and agrees with the entirety of this announcement and the internal competition regulations, as well as, it is understood, that the cyclist competes of his own free will, and with knowledge of the risks involved in this sport and the actions derived from its sporting practice and competition, as well as the accidents that could occur due to the speed and nature of this competition, for which the cyclist himself will assume responsibility for them who presents himself, of his own free will, with knowledge of the risk that could entail, without being obliged by anyone and anything, to be a participant in this sporting competition, thus becoming directly responsible for any situation where, in his case, he could be involved.
- . There will be an ambulance and paramedics on site who will only provide first aid services and transfers to hospitals, public or private.
- In case of requiring transfer to hospitals due to a major accident, this will be to the hospital of choice of the competitor or his companions.

OTHERS AND CHANGES

Issues not covered in this publication, as well as any unspecified point, will be settled by the organizing committee. The organizing committee reserves the right to change any part of this publication.
